Military Service

Army First Lieutenant, including a year in Vietnam, where he received the Bronze Star.

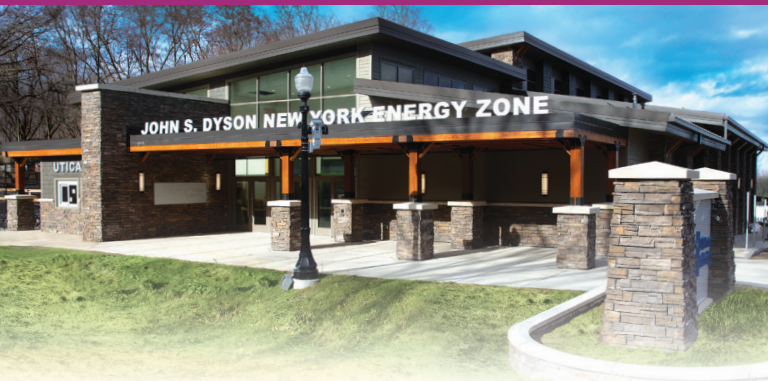

Dyson: Major Accomplishments at NYPA

Clean Energy Pioneer

- Launched multi-faceted program to help break OPEC's stranglehold on the nation's oil supply
- Negotiated a major agreement for New York State to purchase more hydropower from Canada
- Directed licensing and planning for new transmission lines to carry Canadian hydropower and other clean energy

Energy Conservation Advocate

- Among the first government officials to address energy conservation by exploring ways to reduce electricity waste, especially with his "Button Up" program of free home energy surveys

Leader in Creating Jobs

- Established the landmark "Juice for Jobs" program, helping to support thousands of jobs. Today's ReCharge NY program, created by Gov. Andrew M. Cuomo and administered by NYPA, is a direct descendant of Dyson's efforts

Shaping the Future

- Led efforts to fight climate change and ensure clean, reliable energy supply through key roles in advancing Governor Cuomo's Energy Highway Blueprint and other initiatives
